

Georgia Rotarians since 1946 have promoted "world peace through understanding" and shared Will Watt's dream that students from war-torn Europe, eager for peace, could come to the United States and study in Georgia colleges and universities and learn about the American way of life.

In the Fall of 1946, three young men and one young woman from European countries became the first Rotary-sponsored students to attend schools in Georgia.

Through the years, the interest of Georgia Rotarians in this program grew in intensity; the per capita contribution by Rotarians and the special club donations increased, permitting a steady increase in the number of scholarships granted. GRSP is a special and unique international service project of all the Rotary Districts in Georgia. There is no other Program like GRSP in the entire Rotary World. GRSP pre-dates The Rotary Foundation's Ambassadorial Scholarship Program by one year. GRSP receives no funding from the Rotary Foundation. It is funded solely by Georgia Rotary Clubs and Georgia Rotarians.

In the years since the inception of the program, more than 3,692 young men and women from 114 countries have been brought to Georgia campuses by Rotarians. It is the desire of GRSP that students return to their home countries after completing their year in Georgia to become active members in their communities and serve mankind through Rotary. We have many exciting stories about former students who have become very influential members of society and quite accomplished in the business world.

IN HIS LIFETIME, WILL WATT WAS SINGLED OUT FOR HIS BRAVE LEADERSHIP AND FOR HIS TIRELESS SERVICE. HE WAS EVENTUALLY MADE AN HONORARY CITIZEN OF LUNEBERG (ONE OF ONLY TWO PEOPLE SO HONORED IN 1,200 YEARS), AND HE WAS DECORATED AND KNIGHTED BY THE KING OF NORWAY. THE WILL WATT MEMORIAL FOUNTAIN IS PATTERNED AFTER A FOUNTAIN FEATURED IN LÜNEBURG.

# **DONOR RECOGNITION LEVELS**

#### NAMED SCHOLARSHIP:

A contribution of \$100,000 or more will earn the donor a permanent Named Scholarship in their name or the name of an individual designated by the donor.

#### FRANK BENTLEY, SR. FELLOW:

A contribution of \$25,000 or more will earn the Frank Bentley, Sr. Fellow designation, honoring this past GRSP Endowment Chairman. He guided the Endowment Fund in the '90s to successful campaigns that gave the GRSP financial stability. He was a member of the Rotary Club of Sandy Springs.

#### HART JOINER FELLOW:

A contribution of \$20,000 or more will earn the Hart Joiner Fellow designation, honoring one of the original 12 Trustees selected in the program in 1958. A member of the Rotary Club of Gainesville, he was host to many GRSP students and also served as GRSP Chairman in 1964-65.

#### JIM BRIM FELLOW:

A contribution of \$15,000 or more will earn the Jim Brim Fellow designation, honoring this dedicated GRSP Trustee from the Rotary Club of Pelham.

He wrote the original GRSP By-Laws and served as Vice Chair of the GRSP program.

#### **RONNIE WALLER FELLOW:**

A contribution of \$10,000 or more will earn the Ronnie Waller Fellow designation, honoring this original Endowment Chairman who guided the Endowment through a significant period of expansion. A member of the Rotary Club of Gainesville, he also served as the GRSP Chairman.

#### JAKE CHEATHAM FELLOW:

A contribution of \$7,500 or more will earn the Jake Cheatham Fellow designation, honoring this long time GRSP Trustee. Jake served as the GRSP Secretary/Treasurer for over 30 years. He was a member of the Rotary Club of Griffin.

#### **KENDALL WEISIGER FELLOW:**

A contribution of \$5,000 or more will earn the Kendall Weisiger Fellow designation, which honors this Atlanta Rotarian, whose support of international students through the Rotary Education Foundation of Atlanta was merged into GRSP.

#### **HUE THOMAS FELLOW:**



## WILLIAM A. "MR. WILL" WATT, SR. FOUNDER OF GEORGIA ROTARY STUDENT PROGRAM

William A. "Mr. Will" Watt, Sr., was a Rotary District Governor and Mayor of Thomasville in the 1940s. A Sunday School teacher and lay minister, Mr. Will was loved by all and was known for his kind, gentle spirit. As World War II ended, U.S. cities were asked to adopt a German city and share food and clothing with hose struggling to survive in war torn Germany. Under Mayor Will's direction, supplies and goods were flown to Thomasville's adopted city, Luneburg, Germany. In 1946, having seen the damage of war in Europe, he founded the Georgia Rotary Student Program (GRSP). He believed that "Peace through Understanding" would be possible if students from foreign countries came to Georgia colleges and universities to study for one year, develop a better understanding of their fellow man, and carry the message back to their own countries. This fountain is a tribute to the memory of William A. "Mr. Will" Watt, Sr., founder of GRSP. May all who enjoy this fountain reflect on Mr. Will's life of service and share his desire for world peace.

The Georgia Rotary Student Program (GRSP) was founded in 1946, by William A. "Mr. Will" Watt, Sr., of the Rotary Club of Thomasville, Georgia. The Vision to develop leaders who promote understanding and peace throughout the world is fulfilled through its Mission. GRSP provides scholarships to advance cultural understanding and social experiences through friendship; develops potential global leaders; and expands the ideals of Rotary around the world. For generations, Rotary Districts 6900, 6910, and 6920, have promoted world peace by generously funding and offering scholarships to international students for one year of study in Georgia colleges and universities. Students become adopted members of a Georgia Rotary Club "host family," while living on-campus and often spend weekends and holidays with host parents. GRSP international students make friends from other nations and learn about differing cultures and lifestyles. Georgia Rotarians believe "Peace is Possible," and through GRSP promote international goodwill. GRSP is the only program of its kind in the Rotary world.
